



### Eligible Hospitals

#### How can the West Virginia Health Information Network (WVHIN) assist you in meeting Meaningful Use requirements?

The charts below define Stage 1 & Stage 2 Meaningful Use objectives associated with the electronic exchange of patient health information and describe how WVHIN services can assist eligible hospitals (EHs) in meeting Meaningful Use objectives. *Table A* addresses Stage 1 requirements and *Table B* addresses Stage 2 requirements.
