Thank you for your interest in joining the WVHIN where we are focused on developing a fully interoperable statewide network to facilitate public and private use of healthcare information in the state while ensuring the privacy and security of patient healthcare information. This readiness assessment has been designed as a tool to assist your organization in determining its ability to share and receive using standards compliant connections.

This document is designed to gain high-level insight into your technical capability to connect (more detailed technical design discussions will follow later in the process). Secondly, the WVHIN will use this information to begin to qualify your facility for scheduling and connection design.

This assessment may have some detailed items where you are unsure or unable to answer. We would encourage you to work with your EHR vendor, your WVMI/WVHII contact or others who may be able to assist you in completing the assessment. Once the assessment is complete, a series of connection design calls may be scheduled, and the appropriate “*Onboarding Guide*” will be shared with you and your EHR vendor for detailed technical connection information.

Once the technical details of the connection are confirmed, you will be placed in the connection onboarding queue.
